2017 JOHN R. PANDOLFI SUMMER STUDY GRANT INFORMATION

The Tri-County Music Association is offering grants for summer music study to high school musicians. Private instruction, camps and summer programs all qualify. Grants in the past were applied to the Tanglewood Institute, the SUNY Purchase Jazz Institute, the Vermont Vocal Arts Institute, The New England Conservatory Youth Symphony Orchestra trip to Greece, the Summer Youth Music School in New Hampshire, The Music Institute at Rhode Island College and the Jack Martin Trumpet Camp.

Eligibility: Applicants must be high school (grades 9-12) music students whose families reside in the Tri-County area (Barnstable, Bristol and Plymouth counties) of Southeastern Massachusetts.

Application Deadline: April 1, 2017

Grant Awards Finalized: June 1, 2017. Notification will be by mail. Funds will be distributed upon receipt of written proof of completion of the summer study. Written proof of completion must be sent by September 30, 2017.
